OVERVIEW

This policy is intended to ensure consistency across the school in terms of home learning practice.

OBJECTIVES

- To encourage children to develop organisational skills and self- discipline
- To bridge the gap between home and school and to provide parents and carers with direct involvement in children's learning
- To develop children's independent learning skills
- To personalise learning and develop children's self-motivation and self-confidence

HOMEWORK ACTIVITIES AND EXPECTATIONS ACROSS THE SCHOOL

All homework will be set in the red Homework books unless otherwise stated.

- Reading 5 times per week (recorded in the homework book)
- Spelling practice in homework book
- Weekly Maths activities linked to areas for development highlighted in assessments in the previous week at school.
- Weekly English activities linked to the topics being covered in English lessons
- There may be some additional activities provided linked to topic work being carried out in class, but this will not be weekly.

HOMEWORK TIMINGS

Math and English

Set and sent home on Mondays. Hand in on Fridays.

Topic

Set and sent home on Mondays. Hand in on Fridays.

Spellings

Set and sent home on Mondays. Hand in on Fridays.

Reading books or reading sheets

Sent home every day.



FURTHER INFORMATION

The homework books should be brought into school daily with reading completed at home recorded by an adult. This can also be used to communicate any questions/queries/notes for class teachers or other school staff.

Teachers will award merits for homework completed to a high standard and handed in on time.
